- ⇒ Encourage the study of a second language;

- ⇒ Provide universities with a method to recognize and give credit to applicants;

- ⇒ Recognize, promote, and praise students for their accomplishment;
- ⇒ Strengthen relationships and honor the cultures and languages in our community; and
- ⇒ Value diversity

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

### SEAL OF BILITERACY

All students must:

#### Meet any of the English testing criteria

- ◇ Score Proficient or higher on the English 10 EOC
- ◇ Score 18 or higher on ACT Reading Portion
- ◇ Score 4.0 or higher on ACCESS (ELL students)

#### Meet any of the World Language testing criteria

- ◇ Score “Intermediate Mid” or higher on all 4 modes (reading, writing, listening, and speaking) of the STAMP4S Exam
- ◇ Score of 4 or higher on the IB SL or HL exam.

### DISTINGUISHED SEAL OF BILITERACY

All students must:

#### Meet any of the English testing criteria

- ◇ Score Proficient or higher on the English 10 EOC
- ◇ Score 21 or higher on ACT Reading Portion
- ◇ Score 4.7 or higher on ACCESS (ELL students)

#### Meet any of the World Language testing criteria

- ◇ Score “Advanced Low” or higher on all 4 modes (reading, writing, listening, and speaking) of the STAMP4S Exam
- ◇ Score 6 or higher on the IB SL exam
