SEAL OF BILITERACY

All students must:

Meet any of the English testing criteria

- Score Proficient or higher on the English 10 EOC
- Score 18 or higher on ACT Reading Portion
- Score 4.0 or higher on ACCESS (ELL students)

Meet any of the World Language testing criteria

- Score "Intermediate Mid" or higher on all 4 modes (reading, writing, listening, and speaking) of the STAMP4S Exam
- Score of 4 or higher on the IB SL or HL exam.

DISTINGUISHED SEAL OF BILITERACY

All students must:

Meet any of the English testing criteria

- Score Proficient or higher on the English 10 EOC
- Score 21 or higher on ACT Reading Portion
- Score 4.7 or higher on ACCESS (ELL students)

Meet <u>any</u> of the World Language testing criteria

- Score "Advanced Low" or higher on all 4 modes (reading, writing, listening, and speaking) of the STAMP4S Exam
- Score 6 or higher on the IB SL exam
